



In 1953, Dwight D. Eisenhower was inaugurated as the 34th President of the United States, the cost of a postage stamp was three cents, and Savage began a community celebration known as Dan Patch Days. With a parade, a watermelon eating contest, and even horse races downtown, the small town celebrated its most famous resident - a horse named Dan Patch.

Dan Patch has been called The King Of The Pacers, The World's Champion Harness Horse, The Great Dan Patch and the greatest harness horse in the history of the two-wheel sulky. The only horse in racing history to break the two-minute mile barrier 35 times!

Over the years this event has grown to attract over 10,000 people during the four day run. Planning the event has become a year long process for Dan Patch Days, Inc and its all volunteer board. In addition, over 500 volunteers contribute their time and talents to make the event a success.

Our mission is to inspire, enlighten, and delight all our visitors while we use the proceeds to maintain and enhance community organizations. Top 10 Best Affordable Suburbs in America 2010

By Venessa Wong, BusinessWeek

Life with children is expensive, but in some places a dollar goes a lot further. Bloomberg BusinessWeek evaluated information provided by community neighborhoods; data company OnBoard Informatics to determine the best affordable suburb in each state.

While many of the places on this year's list are near amenities such as country clubs and golf courses, the focus is not luxury, but rather communities where families can live well for less and enjoy good schools low crime, and reasonable commutes.

The selected suburbs were limited to towns within 25 miles of the most populated city in the state, with populations of 5,000 to 60,000, median family incomes of \$51,000 to \$120,000, and lowerthan-average crime rates. They weighted a variety of factors including livability (short commutes, low pollution, green space), education (well-educated residents, high test scores), crime (low personal and property crime), economy (high job growth, low unemployment rate, high family income), and affordability (median household income, cost of expenditures). Affordability was most heavily weighted in our calculations. We penalized places with bad weather, a lack of racial diversity, high divorce rates, and few children.

The results ranged from established high-income neighborhoods to growing middle-income communities. For example, the smallest town on the list,

Cave Creek, Ariz., has a population of about 5,000 and a median family income of \$108,546, while Moore, Okla., one of the largest, has more than 51,000 residents and a median income of \$63,309, according to their estimates. Despite their differences, all these places offer young families an attractive location to raise children and remain close to employment opportunities. Savage was selected as one of the top ten suburbs!




A Great Man an Amazing Horse Dan Patch!

M.W. Savage married in 1881 and was an lowa farmer until the floods ruined his crops. In 1886 Savage sought a new start in Minnesota. Minneapolis had become the center of expanding dairy, farming and livestock industries. Starting in a small stock food manufacturing plant and utilizing the local scientists, he startled the business community in a few years with the purchase of the huge Exposition Building on the river in Minneapolis. There he centered his International Stock Food company.

With his growing wealth, and to satisfy a long cherished ambition to breed champion horses. Will Savage purchased (in about 1895) 750 acres of choice farmland 18 miles southwest of Minneapolis on the Minnesota River near Hamilton — later renamed Savage in his honor. On his estate he built extensive stables, two race tracks (one completely enclosed!) and began buying race horses.

Among them was Dan Patch. This beloved horse would write harness racing history with a record of 1.55 for the mile to set a new world mark for pacers.
