



## Mother Nature's Wrath The Year That Wasn't...

Each year, Dan Patch Days is put on by many dedicated board members, committee members and volunteers. In 2013, severe and unexpected weather struck the event with a fury on Friday, June 20, 2013.

As with any year, Dan Patch Days organizers and emergency management personnel had a constant eye on weather forecasts. No major storms were predicted, and communication with weather watchers in neighboring communities hinted that – at the most – passing showers may be in store. Dark clouds continued to approach. At the first sight of lightening, the band stopped playing and organizers prepared to evacuate the park. Within seconds, 64 mph winds and rain ensued – sending park guests and volunteers running for shelter at the nearby Public Works building.

When the storm had passed, board and committee members returned to the park to assess the situation. Thankfully, there



were no injuries to our guests or volunteers. However, the park didn't fair as well. Several tents were damaged, the power was out and the park grounds were water logged. It was immediately evident the night's activities could not continue.



The board met the following morning to discuss how to proceed. The park grounds, still soggy from the previous night's deluge, were turning to mud as volunteers cleaned up damaged tents and debris. While power had been restored to Community Park and the surrounding area, thousands of homes and businesses in the area were without electricity and there was no promise that it would be restored soon.

With heavy hearts and using the best information available at the time, the board decided to reduce the risks and cancel the remaining activities.

To ensure the ongoing success and sustainability of our community celebration as well as the safety of our guests, *you will experience a few changes* with respect to park access beginning this year...Most notably, coolers and outside food and beverages will no longer be permitted in the park the entire weekend. With exciting bands, family activities, great food and fun planned, Dan Patch Days is set to highlight what makes Savage a great community. Enjoy Dan Patch Days 2014 and we look forward to seeing you during this year's celebration!

The first button was sold in 1953 and the entire collection is on display at the museum at the library. A button is mandatory to participate in the horseshoe hunt.

The horseshoe hunt started 17 years ago as a means to spark interest in the history of the city. Clues will appear on the Dan Patch Historical Society website, www.danpatch.com, and the Savage Pacer, five weeks before the event to find the hidden horseshoe located on public property. The finder receives \$100 and an opportunity to ride in the grand parade. The button and the hunt are sponsored by the Dan Patch Historical Society with the clue master being one of its members.

#### Meet our 2014 Grand Marshal of the Dan Patch Days Parade!


#### **JACK W. BERGMAN**




