

Fun Facts about the 2012 Celebration!

How much do you know about Dan Patch Days 2012? Here is our top 10 list of things to know about the annual community celebration, which takes place Thursday, June 21st – Sunday, June 24th at Community Park in Savage.

- "Hairball" is BACK! The rock 'n roll band will perform Friday. Gates open at 6 p.m. and the cost is \$10 per person. "Them Pesky Kids" is the warm up band.
- 2- Everybody loves a parade (or two)! New this year there will be a Neighborhood Float Contest with a first-place prize of \$200. The floats will be a part of the Grand Parade on Sunday in downtown Savage. There will also be a kiddie parade Saturday around Community Park.
- 3. Local community leaders will be judging the "Savage Has Talent" contest, a new event that takes place from noon to 2 p.m. at Community Park on Saturday. A new local band, "Sterio Sunrise" will also be performing Saturday from 4:30 to 6 p.m.
- 4. Save your appetite for the "Taste of Savage," one of the hallmark events at Community Park on Saturday. Food booths open at 4 p.m. and close at 8:30 p.m.
- 5. "Radio Disney" will be broadcasting for two hours Saturday afternoon from Community Park. Enjoy games, music and contests.
- 6. "The Dweebs" are back on Saturday night. The crowd-pleasing fireworks top off the night just after the band's last set.
- 7. Support the Savage Rotary Club's Beer & Wine Tasting under the big tent on Thursday from 7 to 10 p.m. at Community Park. Tickets are \$20 for this event ~ 21 years of age and older please!
- 8. Bring your appetite to the Savage Fire Department's annual pancake breakfast and open house on Sunday from 7:30-11:30 a.m. at the Dakota Avenue Fire Station #60 (near the city hall campus).
- **9.** Dan Patch Days celebrates our most famous resident, a horse named Dan Patch. Dan was a pacer owned by the city's namesake, Marion W. Savage and is known as "the greatest harness horse in the history of the two-wheel sulky" to break the 2 minute mile barrier 35 times.
- 10. Dan Patch Days is about bringing our community together. Our mission is to inspire, enlighten and delight all visitors while using the proceeds to maintain and enhance community organizations. Over the past 7 years, Dan Patch Days, a registered nonprofit, has given back over \$125,000 to community organizations and projects.



Bring the Community Together!

Savage Jaycees started Heritage Days 22 years ago Just over 20 years ago, a group of Jaycees invested a bunch of sweat equity into Heritage Days, a community celebration that was eventually renamed Dan Patch Days.

Art Suel, Rob Fendler, Roy Schneider and Rob Ampe said that even though the Savage Jaycees had no budget to work with, the members had a lot of passion to bring the community together and celebrate the city's heritage.

It was a lot of hard work, but we sure had fun. "

The first thing the group needed to consider was a name. Dan Patch Days started in 1953 and had been a very popular celebration for many years. But in the 1970s, it developed a reputation for rowdiness and came to an abrupt end in 1976 after a violent fight between two men ended with one of them being shot and killed.

After the first Heritage Days in 1990, the celebration grew and eventually incorporated into a formal nonprofit. The name was changed in 1996 to Dan Patch Days.

"It was a lot of hard work, but we sure had fun," Suel recalled of the first years. "We operated on a shoestring budget."

Blue tarps were used to protect the game area and vendors in Hollywood Park, said Fendler, who remembered cobbling the tarps together with other volunteers to create a larger tent. "We made a few bucks each year and eventually we were able to rent more equipment, including a tent," Fendler said. Schneider and his family moved to the city in 1987,

one of thousands of families who moved into new homes being built throughout the city. "We really wanted to bring the two parts of the community together to celebrate – those residents living in the

Mo single person started Dan Patch Days. "

Hamilton District and the new residents," he said of the Jaycees' motivation behind starting Heritage Days.

"No single person started Dan Patch Days, it was a collaboration by various individuals who made it successful," Suel said. "Everyone pitched in and did what needed to be done. The best thing was the community got behind us and Heritage Days grew and eventually became Dan Patch Days." Fendler and Ampe always worked behind the scenes, and continue to do so today. Ampe is

literally the one who powers up Dan Patch Days because he calculates the need for electricity and draws up a plan to make it all work together.

"You have to thoroughly prepare because it might be extremely hot, it might rain, or there could be strong storms. But having a plan makes those unexpected things easier to handle."

Today, as the men look back at what the celebration has become, they say it is almost unbelievable and has exceeded their expectations.





What's NEW *in* **2012?**

Every year Dan Patch Days gets bigger and better as new activities are added to keep things interesting. Some of the new attractions in 2012 include:

Savage Has Talent

The "Savage Has Talent" contest runs from noon to 2 p.m. on Saturday in Community Park. The contest will be judged by a panel of three community leaders and division winners will receive a monetary award.

Auditions took place in April and May to select the talent field. There will be performances by vocalists, instrumentalists, jugglers, magic acts and comedy acts. There is no age restriction for performers and the content will be family friendly. Mauri's School of Dance and American Top Team are the sponsors of this event. They will be doing live performances during "Savage Has Talent," but will not be competing with the other performers for prizes.

Neighborhood Float Contest

Have you always wanted to be in the Grand Day Parade in downtown Savage on Sunday afternoon? If so, enter the Neighborhood Float Contest and construct your floating work of art based on the theme "Movies." First prize is \$200, second is \$100 and third is \$50.

Judging takes place at 11:30 a.m. before the parade begins and all floats must be "parade ready" at that time. Floats can be no larger than 17.5 feet high by 16 feet wide and must be "family friendly."

Them Pesky Kids

"Them Pesky Kids" will be opening for "Hairball" from 7:15 to 8:15 p.m. on Friday at Community Park. The local band has been rocking the Twin Cities with vocals, guitars, bass and monster drums for years. Brian Hollenbeck, Mark Woerpel, Brian Waterman and Mark Westlund promise to "keep your motor running all day" with their original rock 'n roll music. "Them Pesky Kids" recreates the awesome atmosphere of an arena rock show because the musicians bring years of rocking from leading regional bands such as "Touched" and "Warp Drive"

to the international touring act "Blackfoot." The deep vocals provided by three lead singers sets them apart from all other bands.Everything "Them

Pesky Kids" does is huge -- from vocals, guitars, bass and monsters drums to high end stage production. The non-stop rock 'n roll party is infectious and you can't help but get up out of your seat.

In 2008, cousins Nicole, Siobahn and Natalie Fideler put the band together and in 2010 Lauren Smith joined the group. "Sterio Sunrise" has performed at places like The Garage and the Savage Farmers' Market, as well as during previous Dan Patch Days celebrations. They also perform a Christmas show annually at the Mall of America.
