## New DPHS directors and officers named

August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007

The Dan Patch Historical Society held its 2007 Annual Meeting at the Savage Depot on July 25. The purpose of the meeting was to elect four directors whose terms had expired. Re-elected were Rob Fendler, Jim Ross and Greg Lind. Dena Merwin chose not to be reelected. Tom Brennan was elected to her term. The Board then met to elect the following officers: Jens Bohn, president; George Augustinack, vice president, Janet Williams, secretary; Nancy Allen, treasurer. The depot provided the perfect setting for the meeting and for the board to review the "Bring the Depot Home" project that is nearing completion.

Yet to be completed are the signs that say "Savage" on each end. These will look like the originals. We are waiting for the benches to be installed on the cement pads around the brick walk. We are finalizing our list of donors and discussing how they will be acknowledged. They will be listed in the Savage Pacer and on a recognition board inside the depot. A total of 51 businesses and/or individuals donated services/products; 25 made cash donations from \$10,000 to \$4; 258 purchased 311 bricks; and seven purchased six benches.

Pretty impressive when you add up those numbers. We thank each and every one for making it possible!
