## Stop by, see progress on Depot.

January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2007

After much planning and negotiation, progress on the depot is very visible with something new happening every day.

The exterior doors and all of the windows have been installed by Eagle Siding and came from quality Windows and Doors. The exterior sills and trim boards will make them complete.

Eagle Siding is taking off the old siding with Shaw Stewart Lumber delivering the new siding along with the exterior sheathing. Insulation will happen next by Citywide Insulation. Master Electric installed the electrical panel and meter socket so we should have lights as soon as Xcel plugs in the meter. The lighting layout and fixture selection is being provided by Hallquist Design.

On the interior, the wood flooring was taken up by Bud Jacobsen and Jens and Lance Bohn. We have a "to do" list from an engineer for some structural repairs. We will begin to put down the underlayment and begin framing the interior walls so Sherer Plumbing can rough in the plumbing and Gopher Heating can rough in the heating.

We have to say that the businesses and people that have stepped up have done so in a big way, and our thanks goes to them for making this possible.

Of course, all of this does not just happen - Rob Fendler is the one planning, negotiating, scheduling and overseeing the whole renovation. We can't thank him enough.
