The siding is all on and, soon, with the warmer weather, the interior and exterior trim on the windows and doors will be complete. Now we are working on the system to install the old cargo doors inside the new windows.

The heat is on! Thanks to Denny from Gopher/O'Brien heating. The attic insulation is being blown in by Citywide Insulation, the gypsum board is on and the taping will be done soon. Rubble Tile donated the tile for the bathroom, and Shelton Interiors of St. Paul is doing the install for cost. Toilet accessories were donated by Building Material Supply. We have selected the door hardware and color for the exterior lights.

Soon we will be finalizing our landscape plan with 83 additional engraved bricks ordered from our Walk of Fame campaign that just ended Feb. 1. Thanks for the continued support and be sure to take time to thank all of the vendors and workers who are making this possible.
