Get involved in depot project

There are a number of ways to be involved in the Savage depot project - buy a brick, donate money, donate supplies (blocks, cement, paint, shingles, insulation, etc.), donate services (excavation, lay blocks, shingle the roof, carpenter work, paint, etc.) and volunteer.

Another way is the Brick Walk of Fame. In the front of the depot, which will be located in the public square in downtown Savage, we will be designing and installing a walkway of engraved bricks. Buy a special brick permanently imprinted to last a lifetime. Buy bricks for friends, relatives, children, parents, businesses, significant dates, places or "in memory of." A 4-inch by 8-inch brick sells for \$100 and will have three lines maximum, 18 characters per line (including spaces). An 8-inch by 8-inch brick sells for \$175 and will have up to six lines, 18 characters per line. Certificates of the purchase sell for \$5 to be framed or to use as a holiday gift, birthdays, anniversaries, etc.

Brick forms are available on the Web site at www.danpatch.com or at Savage City Hall, Dan Patch and Marketplace Liquor stores, the Savage Public Library and Razors Edge Barber Shop. Buy as many as you want. Send the form and the check to the Dan Patch Historical Society or order through Pay Pal on the Web site.
