Downtown parking lot is shaping up

If you have been to downtown Savage, you noticed the Town Square parking lot work. The retaining wall along Highway 13 has been painted, the curb around the parking lot is in and the first layer of blacktop is expected to be completed within a week. Everyone will be happy to have the parking lot available for use in the area. The space that is just dirt is the future location of the depot, which is at the southeast corner of the Town Square.

In our last column we listed services needed for the depot. We heard from a number of local businesses. We are grateful for Turner Excavating who has offered to dig the foundation, to General Waterproofing for volunteering to waterproof the foundation and to Buckingham Disposal who will be providing the dumpsters. We still need help for the new roof, the cement work for the foundation and restore the site at Murphy's Landing. We are working with the mover to determine the route and timeframe. All donations and services are tax deductible and will be acknowledged by the Dan Patch Historical Society.
