## Depot will be in town soon!

May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2006

At a special meeting of the Dan Patch Historical Society Board of Directors on May 22, the board authorized the president to sign two agreements.

The first was between the city and the society for the depot. The Savage City Council also approved this agreement on May 15. The city will own it and Historical Society will move it to the Town Square. Following the move, the city and the society agree that they will work together to complete any restoration or preservation of the depot so that it may be occupied. The city agrees to maintain the historical integrity of the depot and will not alter the interior or the exterior without having obtained the advice and recommendations of the Historical Society. The society agrees that all monies collected will be used for the depot project.

The second agreement signed was with the mover Lunak. They have begun moving their equipment into Murphy's Landing and will begin jacking up the depot. The roof will then be removed and the depot moved in the middle of a night to its site in the Town Square.

Once there, the footings and foundation will be put under it and it will be lowered onto the foundation.
