

Dan Patch book nominated for MIPA award



"The Great Dan Patch and the Remarkable Mr. Savage" by Tim Brady is a finalist in the Midwest Independent Publishers Association (MIPA) 17th Annual Midwest Book Awards.

The book takes place at the turn of the 20th century, when horses were everywhere and Dan Patch was one of the most famous of all. His owner, M.W. Savage, promoted a variety of products under the Dan Patch name, making him the nation's first sports superstar. Brady tells the story of an era, an entrepreneur, and a well-loved horse that set a world record at the Minnesota State Fair that which held for more than 30 years.

Nodin Press, which published the book, has seven finalists in the running for a variety of awards. There are an unprecedented 146 nominations from 65 publishers in 10 of the 12 Midwestern states in the region and 69 award-winning titles from 35 different publishers.

Awards will be presented at the 2006 Midwest Book Awards ceremony on May 9.
