

STATUE OF M.W. & DAN PATCH Coming to Savage



The 2017 MN Legislature appropriated \$75,000 to the City of Savage for a bronze statue of M.W.Savage and Dan Patch to be located on the Savage Public Library campus. The money is from the State of MN Legacy fund under the history category. Bills for the appropriation were submitted by Senator Dan Hall and Representative Drew Christensen with committee testimony from Savage Mayor Janet Williams and Dan Patch Project Leader Kari Lundin. The city is required to have a \$25,000 match and is working with the Dan Patch Historical Society to achieve that goal by the end of the year.

The city signed a contract with the State of MN and with the sculptor Alexa King for the work to be completed in the Spring 2018. The city agreed to provide the site and maintain it. The statue will be one third actual size and placed on a plithe. The historical society at their annual meeting recommended the pose and location. Finally the city will have a statue of its namesake, Marion Willis Savage and his beloved horse Dan Patch.
